






 Install Hand Held WK Adapter Kit from Wall Kit.
(Hose and Escutcheon provided with valve will not be used)





• Determine if you have a left or right hand tub. (Drain and door end will determine if it is a left or right hand). Shelves go on drain end.

(Left-Hand Shown)




- Identify all parts.
- Position End Panels with Middle
- Panel on a flat surface.
- Allow sufficient room around all panels for easy access.






- Clamp the three panels together. Make sure inside face of all three panels are flush.
- Center and drill five 1/4" dia. holes along the length of the two joints as illustrated.
- Assemble with bolt, metal washer, rubber washer, and nut in each hole as shown and tighten.




 Apply and center continuous D-shaped base gasket on bottom wall flange.





- Clamp down wall assembly to tub making sure it is flush with front tub corners.
- Drill eleven 1/8" dia. holes as illustrated.
- Attach wall assembly to tub with short screw, metal washer and rubber washer.




- Drill two 1/4" dia. holes "A" for shower slide bar with bracket. (Centered in raised rib of panel).
- Drill two 3/16" dia. holes "B" for curtain rod.
- Using 2-holed washer (② 2-holed washer) from curtain rod as a template, drill two more 3/16" dia. holes "C" for correct placement.




- Assemble shower slide bar with bracket and attach to wall with bolt, metal washer and rubber washer and nut.
- Connect hand held shower to hose.
- Hang hand held shower onto shower slide bar bracket.
- Tighten all bolts and nuts and secure screws.
- Verify and tighten all plumbing connections.
- Verify that unit is level and secure.




- Attach wall angle with long screws to existing wall.
- Slide completed unit into its final position.
- Using short screws, plastic washers and caps, secure wall assembly to wall angle.





• Determine location of filler panel.




• Install tub rail to tub and wall kit with short screws.









- Measure and cut filler panel to fit the space.
- Place filler panel caps on top and bottom of filler panel.
- Insert uncut side of panel into tub rail. Attach other side to wall rail with plastic washer & caps and short screws.







- Measure and cut filler panel to fit the space.
